Born in 1977, Shruti Mahajan completed her bachelor's in Painting from the Maharaja Sayaji Rao University, Faculty Of Fine Arts, Baroda and was awarded the Nasreen Mohamadi Scholarship in her final year. She went on to pursue a diploma in textile design in 2004, from the National Institute of Design, Ahemdabad.
